



ARC Project Snapshot: Chino Valley Unified School District

In efforts to improve HVAC systems for staff and students, the Chino Valley Unified School District utilized the Advanced Rooftop Control (ARC) pilot to upgrade multiple schools with better equipment and controls.

“The ARC Pilot is a great resource for school districts that don’t have funding to update or install a new system that offers better control of equipment,” states Chris Sheriff, Chino Valley Unified School District Facilities Director.

Three energy-saving projects resulted in:

- \$71,270 in rebates
- 460,454 kWh in energy savings

Energy reduction results equate to more than:

- 4.9 million pounds of carbon eliminated
- 4,847 trees planted
- 1.2 million gallons of water saved
